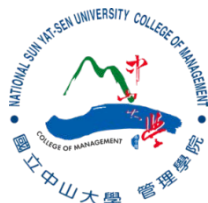

The world looks different from here.

College of Management in NSYSU has reached an agreement with the University of Victoria (UVic), Canada. Students who participate in the program study first two years in NSYSU, and then transfer directly to the third year of UVic. Upon successfully completing year 3 and year 4 in UVic, students would not only receive the bachelor's degree from NSYSU, they would also receive a Bachelor of Commerce Degree from UVic. Joining this program you would have two diplomas, one from Asia, and one from Canada!

1. Program Admission Requirements

- Quota : 15 students per year
- Course requirements:

- Language Requirement:
 - TOFEL 575 paper based
 - 90 iBT (with no section less than 20)
 - IELTS 6.5 (with no component less than 6.0)
 - ※ Exam scores must be sent directly to UVic from the exam center.

- It is also possible to apply for Conditional Admission, which requires students to take a 4-week UAP (University Admission Preparation) course in August and pass with 80%. Minimum requirements for conditional admission are:
 - IELTS 6.0 (no component less than 5.5)
 - TOEFL 79 (17 in each section)
 - 550 on PBT
 - Students also have until July 1st to continue to submit a sufficient exam score in order to gain regular admission.
- Academic writing requirement:
This requirement will be met through the successful completion of a designated English course at UVic.
- Grade Requirement:
 - At least B in average every semester. (80%)
 - At least B- for each of the required courses. (65%)(table 1)
- Application form:
Submit a supplemental application from outlining experiences and attributes indicating your suitability for this program.

2. Evaluation:

- Documentary review : 40% (application form, English transcript)
- Academic skills: 60% (Academic performance in NSYSU)

2. Course Requirements in UVic:

- Three required co-operative education (work internship approximately 420 hours of paid work) Students can earn between \$7500-\$1000 CAD for each work term (12-16 weeks each).
